Do you wish to prolong your exemption?

If you wish to prolong your exemption, you have to show up in person at your Citizen Service Centre. Remember to bring proof of identity (for example your health insurance card). If you are not able to go to the Citizen Service Centre yourself, someone else can represent you via a power of attorney. If you need help, please contact the Citizen Service Centre.

Do you wish to register for Digital Post?

If you wish to receive Digital Post from public authorities, go to www.borger.dk or www.e-boks.dk and register. You need a NemID to log on, which you can order online at www.nemid.nu. It is also possible to grant reading access to people you trust so that they can check your Digital Post for you. If you need help, go to your Citizen Service Centre or a public library.

What happens if I do not prolong my exemption from Digital Post?

If you do not prolong your exemption, you will automatically be signed up for Digital Post from 1 November 2016. This means that your letters from public authorities, for example letters from the municipality or the hospital, will be sent to you in your Digital Post mailbox from 1 November 2016.

If you have had the expiry of your exemption from Digital Post processed at your Citizen Service Centre within the last couple of weeks, please disregard this letter.
