

# Your temporary exemption from Digital Post will now be indefinite



Your municipality has previously granted you temporary exemption from receiving Digital Post.

The Danish Parliament (Folketinget) has decided that these exemptions are to be indefinite instead of temporary. Consequently, your temporary exemption will automatically become indefinite.

## **Do you still want to be exempt from Digital Post?**

Your temporary exemption will automatically become indefinite, so if you still want to be exempt from receiving Digital Post, you don't have to do anything. You will continue to receive letters from the public authorities by traditional letter post.

## **Would you like to register for Digital Post?**

If you want to receive mail from the public authorities online, you should log on to Digital Post at [www.borger.dk](http://www.borger.dk) or [www.e-boks.dk](http://www.e-boks.dk).

You need a NemID in order to log on. You can order your NemID at [www.nemid.nu](http://www.nemid.nu).

If you need help, please contact your citizen service centre, who can help with the issue of your NemID. Remember to bring photo ID (e.g. a valid passport or driver's licence). If you have no photo ID, you should bring two other types of ID, one of which should state your civil registration number.
