

COHABITANT - LUMP SUM ON DEATH

If you and your deceased cohabitant were not resident in Denmark and were not registered with ATP as cohabitants, you need to complete this form to request payment of the lump sum benefit from ATP. You also have to fill in the bank information form on page 2. In order for you to qualify for the lump sum benefit, the following conditions must be fulfilled:

- the deceased died no later than five years after the retirement age of the deceased.
- the deceased must have been a member of ATP for at least two years after 1 January 2002, and
- since 1 January 2002, the deceased must have paid the equivalent of two years' full contributions to ATP.
- The lump sum decreases by DKK 15,000 every year after the retirement age of the deceased. The amount
 will lapse entirely five years after the retirement age of the deceased.

ATP checks whether these conditions are fulfilled prior to payment of the lump sum benefit.
