<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>As a general rule, you are considered single if you live alone, and cohabiting if you live together with another person.</li><li>However, the decisive factor in determining whether you are regarded as cohabiting is whether you share a joint household with another person. Sharing a joint household means that, taken as a whole, you have financial and/or practical advantages that correspond to the advantages typically enjoyed by married couples or cohabiting partners.</li><li>Financial advantages may include, for example, jointly paying expenses for daily living or fixed, recurring expenses. This may also include jointly owning real estate, a vehicle, or other major financial investments.</li><li>Practical advantages may include, for example, taking turns doing grocery shopping, cooking, doing laundry, or otherwise regularly helping each other in a similar manner.</li><li>You may be considered cohabiting with a person to whom you are not romantically involved or married. However, you cannot be considered cohabiting with your own children, grandchildren, siblings, or parents.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>If you or your spouse live in a nursing home, you are not considered to be cohabiting.</li></ul> <p>At the same time, I declare that I am aware that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>I am obliged to cooperate in the processing of the case and to notify Udbetaling Danmark without delay of any changes to the information provided, if such changes can be expected to affect the pension.</li><li>Any incorrect or missing information may result in my being required to repay amounts paid.</li><li>If, through gross negligence or deliberately I provide incorrect or misleading information, I can be fined or sentenced to imprisonment.</li></ul>
