The Supplementary Labour Market Pension Scheme for Disability Pensioners/Senior Pensioners

Do you want to make additional savings for retirement?

As a disability pensioner/senior pensioner, you have the opportunity to contribute to the Supplementary Labour Market Pension Scheme.

The Supplementary Labour Market Pension Scheme for Disability Pensioners/Senior Pensioners provides a lifelong supplement to your state pension, which can ease the transition from disability pension/senior pension to state pension.

The pension benefits can be paid when you reach the retirement age of Danish state pension.

The pension benefits are taxable on payment.

The size of the pension benefits depends on how much has been contributed, and the return generated.

What does it cost

You have to pay one third yourself, while the state pays the remaining two-thirds. The contribution is not included in your taxable income. This means that your share will be deducted from your disability pension/senior pension before tax is calculated. The contribution will be adjusted once a year, just like your disability pension/senior pension.

Where can the amount be contributed

You can choose to contribute the amount to ATP, a life insurance company or a pension fund. However, not all life insurance companies and pension funds accept contributions to the Supplementary Labour Market Pension Scheme for Disability Pensioners/Senior Pensioners.

If you want to contribute the amount to a life insurance company or pension fund, please contact the company in advance to check whether it is possible. However, you can always contribute the amount to ATP.

Once you are registered for a scheme, Udbetaling Danmark automatically pays the total contribution to the pension institution (ATP, life insurance company or pension fund) you have chosen. The contributions automatically cease when you reach Danish state retirement age.

Paying social security contributions

Since it is a labour market pension scheme, the pension institution deducts social security contributions (AMB) of 8% of the total contributions paid for the year.

Registration

Registration for the Supplementary Labour Market Pension is voluntary.

If you want to register for a scheme, you must fill out an application form and send it to Udbetaling Danmark.

If you choose to contribute the amount to ATP, the scheme will take effect immediately. If you have decided for the scheme to be administered by a life insurance company or pension fund, Udbetaling Danmark will forward your application to the relevant life insurance company or pension fund for approval.

You can choose to join the scheme at any time

Stopping contributions and changing pension institution (ATP, life insurance company or pension fund)

You can always stop your contributions to the Supplementary Labour Market Pension again, or change to another pension institution.

The stop of contributions or the change to another pension institution will take effect on the 1st day of the month, following the month when you notified Udbetaling Danmark.

You cannot transfer or merge contributions paid to one institution with contributions paid to another institution.

Death

If you die before reaching the Danish state retirement age, the contributions will stop with effect from the 1st day of the month following the date of death.

If you had the scheme with ATP and die before the Danish state retirement age, ATP will pay a lump sum to the estate, which makes up half of the contributions paid in to the scheme, added interest minus tax. If you die after the Danish state retirement age, the lump sum will be gradually reduced over five years, from the time you reached the Danish state retirement age.

If you had the scheme with a life insurance company or pension fund, the value of the pension entitlement will be paid to the estate or to the beneficiary under the pension agreement.
